The USDA Forest Service's Resources Planning Act (2020) Assessment used LANDFIRE data to assess recent and future drought exposure for rangeland vegetation types across the western U.S. In addition, they will discuss some emerging technologies for evaluating vegetative drought response and fuels management reliant on several forms of LANDFIRE data.

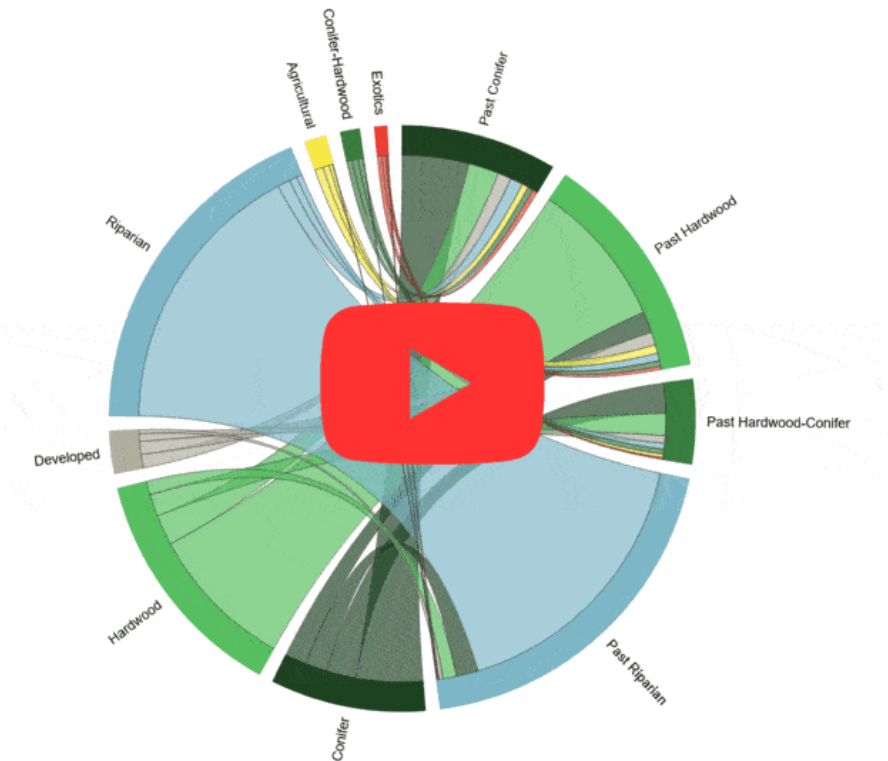

The updated LANDFIRE Portfolio, a modern version of our initial interactive WHAM! web-app, showcases recent LANDFIRE applications.

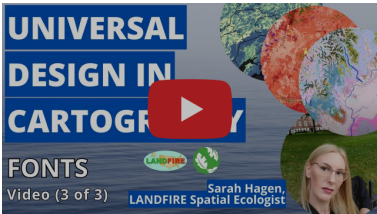
