

Fisheries Division Completes New Berthing Station for MPA Boats

The Fisheries Division of the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands, Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment has successfully completed the construction of a berthing station at the Melville Street Fish Market.

This berthing area will improve the security of both the MPA patrol boat and new MPA workboat, which is now actively in use for conducting biophysical monitoring and lionfish culling in the Moliniere-Beausejour MPA. The area will also protect both vessels from damage caused by other fishing vessels, which also utilize the Fish Market Jetty.

Funding for the construction of the berthing station was provided by the Government of Grenada and the Eastern Caribbean Marine Managed Areas Network (ECMMAN) program. The new mpa workboat was donated by the Caribbean Aqua - Terrestrial Solutions (CATS) program.
